## JAPAN-AFRICA Public-Private Economic Forum

The Forum will consist of plenary and thematic sessions as well as several side events including business networking events such as B2B meetings. The *Japan Fair* will showcase Japanese products and other events include possible special sessions focusing on specific themes such as investment promotion and technology transfer and entrepreneurship.

We are looking forward to meeting you at the Forum which we hope will provide an excellent opportunity to further engage with Japan.
