



Air France to adjust schedule from/to South Africa due to COVID-19 pandemic

In view of the travel restrictions being implemented by countries as a result of the COVID-19 outbreak, Air France is making adjustments to its network worldwide, including South Africa.

Air France flight operations from Johannesburg and Cape Town to Paris will remain at full capacity until 23 March 2020. With effect 24 March 2020, Air France will suspend its flights from Johannesburg and Cape Town to Paris until further notice.

The last Air France flights before suspension between South Africa and Paris are listed as below (all times are local):
