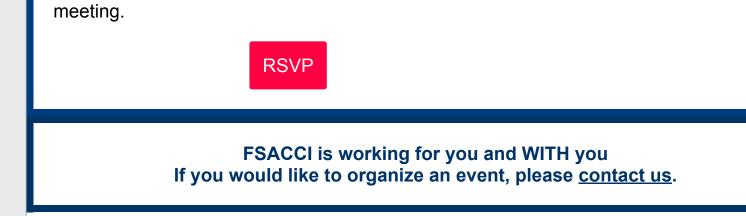


FSACCI ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
