Air France – KLM to adjust schedule from/to South Africa due to COVID-19 pandemic

The ongoing coronavirus Covid-19 crisis has forced Air France – KLM to reduce its flight capacity by almost 90%. This reduction impacts the flights from/to South Africa and are expected to last until the end of May for Air France and until the end of June for KLM.

- <u>All Air France flights between Johannesburg and Paris & Cape Town and Paris remain</u> <u>suspended until 31st May 2020.</u>
- <u>All KLM flights between Cape Town and Amsterdam remain suspended until 3rd July 2020.</u>
- KLM flights between Johannesburg to Amsterdam will be resumed after the lockdown ends.

Per 01st May 2020, KLM expects to operate 3 flights per week between Johannesburg and Amsterdam. This schedule is valid until 3rd July 2020.

As the situation is constantly changing, Air France – KLM will continue to monitor the situation will adjust our flight schedule as and when required. The Air France schedule for June and onwards and the KLM schedule for July and onwards will be communicated once confirmed.

If you have an Air France or KLM ticket and your flight has been cancelled

If you purchased your ticket directly from our website or at an Air France agency, you can:

- 1. Postpone (before 30 September 2020) your trip until 30 November 2020 without any fee in the same cabin of transport on Air France, KLM, Delta Air Lines, Virgin Atlantic and Kenya Airways flights.
- 2. Apply for a refund. Complete the online form (see link below) to obtain a travel voucher. This voucher is valid for 1 year from date of issue on all Air France, KLM, Delta Air Lines, Virgin Atlantic and Kenya Airways flights. This voucher will be refundable for cash after one year from date of issue if it is not used.
