- Shaping the governance of frontier science and disruptive technologies (e.g. Artificial Intelligence) to achieve social justice;
- Advancing the <u>African agenda for science</u> and African participation in global science (inclusive global cooperation);
- Leveraging science diplomacy as instrument to reinforce global solidarity and multilateralism.
